Codex Committee on Food Labelling (CCFL)

Food Labelling in Joint Presentation and Multipacks: CCFL invites Members and Observers to join an EWG, chaired by Colombia and co-chaired by Jamaica, working in English and Spanish, to prepare a preliminary draft text on food labelling in joint presentation formats and in multiple packages.
